- Similar level of need as Levi Leonard Elementary
- Terrazzo floors
- Condition of the locker rooms
- Underutilization of the exterior courtyard
- Interesting existing spaces with opportunity and potential for improvement
- Condition of the building was better than Levi Leonard in some ways, though the building is older
- Well-utilized building, but poor interior traffic flow
- Mostly non-thermally broken windows
- Lockers are too large for some of the younger students
- Alternative high school program is located at the Intermediate School
