CANVASSING OF SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION RETURNS MINUTES

A meeting of the canvassing of school board election returns took place on Monday, April 9, 2018, at 4:00 pm in the District Office conference room.

Those in attendance: Kelly Mosher, John Rasmussen, and Lindsay Krull.

The Evansville Community School District (#1694) Board of Education of Canvassers met in open session under Wisconsin Statutes 19.83 and 19.84, 7.53(3)(a) and 120.06(14). Board of canvassers: Eric Busse, Kelly Mosher, and Jennifer Hansen, tabulated the election results from the City of Evansville, townships of Brooklyn, Center, Janesville, Magnolia, Porter, Rutland, and Union.

Canvassers certified the number of votes given for the candidates and certified that the following persons received the greatest number of votes and the two open school board seats for three year terms and one open seat for a one year term of the Evansville Community School District will go to Kathi Swanson and Ellyn Paul for the three year seats and Curtis Nyhus for the one year term.

The District did not obtain the poll books from the City of Evansville, townships of Brooklyn, Center, Janesville, Magnolia, Porter, Rutland, and Unions, as they have in their possession if the District needs them.

Motion by Ms. Mosher, seconded by Ms. Krull, moved to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried, voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 4:10 pm.
