The Evansville Community School District shall offer programs in Career and Technical Education that will develop work skills, behaviors, attitudes and maturity in the areas of Family and Consumer Science, Technical Education, Business Education and Agriculture Science.

Opportunities for career exploration and insights into work relationships should be available to all students through academic and career planning. Programs of Career and Technical Education shall be provided to all students who want or can benefit from such a program.

Academic and Career Planning is intended to equip students and their families with the tools necessary to make more informed choices about postsecondary education, training, careers for life after high school.

Career and Technical Education opportunities will be maintained and improved within the present vocational disciplines to reflect current labor market information and to improve the content, methodology, resources and opportunities within those disciplines.
