4. Goals Update:
a. ECSD Report Cards from 2012-2013 through recent years were were compared, excluding 2014-2015 when the DPI did not supply report cards.
i. The Closing Gaps and On-Track \& Postsecondary Readiness categories were noted as specific strengths in the ECSD.
b. District ELA goals from 2016 through 2020 were discussed. Potential revisions to these goals were discussed.
c. Melissa Hammann shared data and its methods of calculations through the use of a spreadsheet. Through this discussion Scott shared plans to have Eric Larson from CESA 6 work with the ECSD to better assess the relationship between what is being assessed and what is being taught.
d. Sydney Tepp shared her experience with test prep and its benefits to students.
5. Book Study:
a. ECSD Report Cards were compared with those from the Winneconne Community School detailed in Grading for Impact.
b. Scott Everson has reached out to the authors of Grading for Impact and those responsible for the successful growth of student learning in the Winneconne Community School District. He shared his long-range vision in following the Winneconne model focussed on learning not points or grades. The focus is on learning targets, rather than tasks completion, percentages and points.
