MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING MEETING  
February 9, 2009

A school board public hearing of the Board of Education of the Evansville Community School District was held Monday, February 9, 2009, at 5:30 p.m. in the Theodore Robinson Intermediate School Library, under Chapter 117 Wis. Statutes, "Petition to Alter School District Boundaries", by Donald & Misty Wanta.

The meeting was called to order by School Board President, Michael Pierick. It was noted that the resolution which set forth the date and time of this hearing also contained Pierick's appointment as chair. Other board members present were: Rossmiller, Hatfield, Skinner, Hammann, Swanson, and Herbers.

Motion by Mr. Hatfield, seconded by Ms. Skinner, to nominate Melissa Hammann as secretary. Motion carried, 7-0 (voice vote).

There was no objection to the waiving of the readings of the notices of the hearing.

Mr. Pierick gave an overview of the statutory basis for the petition of land to be detached from the Evansville Community School District and attached to the Oregon School District.

Mr. Pierick gave an overview of the petition from Donald & Misty Wanta, W102 Amidon Road, Brooklyn, WI, 53521.

Mr. Pierick opened the public presentation of the petition.

Ms. Misty Wanta, W102 Amidon Road, Brooklyn, WI 53521, petitioned to detach from the Evansville Community School District and attach to the Oregon School District. She asked to change districts: would be closer to home; more convenient for home and work; and easier for immediate family to help pick up kids from school.

Mr. Pierick asked for school board discussion of issues. Discussion.

Motion by Mr. Herbers, seconded by Ms. Swanson, to deny the transfer of the territory described in the petition. That the reorganization requested in the petition filed on January 28, 2009, to detach territory described in said petition from the Evansville Community School District and to attach it to the Oregon School District be denied and that said petition be dismissed. Motion carried, 7-0 (ballot vote).

Mr. Pierick read the Order of Denial that will be filed with the Department of Public Instruction.

Motion by Mr. Herbers, seconded by Ms. Hammann, to accept the Resolution Authorizing Issuance of an Order. Motion carried, 7-0 (voice vote).

Motion by Mr. Hatfield to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried, 7-0 (voice vote).

Meeting adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
