The District believes that all students should have access to educational technologies such as instructional television, distance learning, computer technology, telecommunications, etc. The Board is committed to providing appropriate hardware, software, professional development, and support to make this possible. The successful utilization of these technologies requires the responsibility of each staff member and student to use these tools for the express purpose of learning within the context of the District curricula.

The District will establish technology plans that monitor the use of technology through the following criteria:

- Equity of access for all students and staff to technology.
- Training for students and staff in how to use technology effectively in the classroom.
- District support including coordination, application, and technical assistance for each school.
