

SCHOOL BUS STOP LOCATIONS FOR STUDENTS



Evansville school buses will pick-up students in grades K-12 who live east of the Highway 14-East Main Street intersection and need transportation to and from school, at the following pick-up stations:

1. Franklin Street Park (K-12)
2. 302 East Main Street (K-12)
3. Corner of Countryside Drive and East Main Street (K-12)
4. 90 Countryside Drive (K-12)
5. 635 Corner of Gunther Drive and East Countryside (K-12)
6. Corner of Noahs Ark Court and N. Water Street (K-12) (Capstone Ridge)
7. Corner of Water Street and Greenview Drive (K-12)
8. 118 Hancock Lane (K-12)
9. 95 Deanna Drive (K-12)

IN-TOWN PICK UP STOPS:

West Side: AM Only

6th Street/Vision Street
6th Street/Abey Drive
6th Street/Prairie View Dr.
6th Street/Porter Road
6th Street/Main Street
6th Street/Garfield Avenue

East Side: AM Only

Garfield Avenue/Eager Court
Garfield Avenue/First Street
Maple Street/Church Street

PLEASE NOTE:

Buses will load and unload behind The Grove Campus (elementary and intermediate schools) off of Fair Street near big gym.

To ensure the safety of our students please note:

Between 7:45 a.m. – 8:15 a.m. and 2:45 p.m. – 3:15 p.m. the Fair Street entrance to the Districts schools will be open to bus traffic only.

Between 7:45 a.m. – 8:15 a.m. and 2:45 p.m. – 3:15 p.m. K-5 students may only be dropped off or picked-up at the front entrances of the Grove Campus off of 4th Street.

We encourage all eligible bus students to ride the bus.

NOTICE REGARDING BUS TRANSPORTATION

According to state statute 121.54 (2), every school board shall provide transportation to and from public school for all pupils who reside in the school district two miles or more from the nearest public school they are entitled to attend. In the Evansville School District there are a few exceptions.

1. Special education students who receive transportation as a related service in their individualized education plan may be transported within the two mile limit. This is consistent with an exception in the statutes.
2. K-12 students in the Countryside area east of town are transported by bus due to safety reasons associated with safe walkways.
3. Croft Road, Old 92, and Hyne Road had been declared hazardous a number of years ago. Therefore students, except those in the Francis addition and N. Crull Court addition, who have access to a walkway, are eligible to ride the buses.

To alleviate traffic congestion on the Grove Campus, we have morning only pick up points.

We encourage all eligible bus students to ride the bus.

3:00 p.m. – Grove Campus (Levi Leonard Elementary and Theodore Robinson Intermediate)

3:10 p.m. – J.C. McKenna Middle School

3:15 p.m. – High School
