Dear Evansville Community School District Families, Staff and Community,

Yesterday, Governor Evers announced that all K-12 school buildings in Wisconsin will remain closed through the end of the school year. We will continue to provide remote learning opportunities just as we have over the past few weeks.

Due to the extension of the “Safer at Home” guidelines through May 26, 2020, access to the buildings continues to be restricted.

We are still hopeful that we can offer summer school in July. We will provide an update in several weeks.
