NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, to qualified electors of the Evansville Community School District, that a school board election will be held in the Evansville Community School District on Tuesday, April 2, 2024. The following offices are to be elected and the incumbents are listed below. The term of office for a school board member is three years beginning on Monday, April 24, 2024.

The two candidates who receive the highest number of votes at the 2024 Spring Election will fill the 3-year terms, the candidate with the third highest number of votes at the 2024 Spring Election will fill the 2-year term.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, that if a primary election is necessary, the primary election will be held on Tuesday, February 20, 2024.

A description of the school district boundaries can be obtained from the school district office.

Acceptable Photo ID will be required to vote at this election. If you do not have a photo ID you may obtain a free ID for voting from the Division of Motor Vehicles.
